44th Asian American International Film Festival Announces Award Winners



August 23, 2021, NEW YORK – The 44th Asian American International Film Festival (AAIFF44) announced the award winners of this year. The award of Emerging Director - Narrative Feature went to KEFF, director of TAIPEI SUICIDE STORY, and the award of Emerging Director - Documentary Feature went to Wei Deng, director of FATHER. The full list of award winners and nominees is highlighted below. A hybrid festival combining in-person events with online screenings, AAIFF44 took place from Aug. 11-22.

AAIFF44 celebrated storytelling by the AAPI community with 102 feature and short films, in-person events such as *Comedy Night Out* and *Music Video Showcase*, as well as in-person and livestreamed panels including *Americanish: A Case Study in American-Muslim Representation, 35 Years of Taipei Stories*, and *A Paradise Lost: Hollywood's Effect on Hawai'i*. 13 jury prize award winners were determined by leading industry professionals including Isabel Sandoval, director/producer/screenwriter of LINGUA FRANCA, Bao Tran, director/producer/screenwriter of THE PAPER TIGERS, and more.
